# "Athletes Engagement" Program including the Anti-Doping Education at the 2018 ITU World Triathlon & Paratriathlon Series Yokohama

ITU, JADA and JTU delivered the "Athlete Engagement" program including the Anti-Doping Education at the athlete hotel on the previous days of the 2018 ITU World Triathlon & Paratriathlon Series Yokohama, 12-13 May 2018. This program was designed for the elite triathletes and paratriathletes to deliver the Anti-Doping Education and disseminate the messages on "TRUTH in Sport" – how they play true – in their own words.

The Athletes had a chance to experience:

- Playing Anti-Doping Quiz
- Writing athletes' message regarding the "TRUTH in Sport" as a commitment to protect clean sport
- Photo shooting of clean sport message for disseminating the message to the youth and the public

Ms Wakako Tsuchida from Japan, winner of the PTWC category, inscribed on the board the "Infinite Possibility" as her own "TRUTH in Sport" message. In addition, Mr Nurbek Toichubaev (PTS4-M category) from Kirgiz Republic, who participated in the PLAY TRUE Torch Relay<sup>\*1</sup> in 2016 to relay the "TRUTH" message in sport, also visited the booth. He described "Leadership, Challenge, Discipline and Motivation" as his "TRUTH in Sport", and promised his continuous commitment to PLAY TRUE 2020<sup>\*2</sup> project.

To deliver the updated Anti-Doping information to the top-level triathletes directly, the PLAY TRUE Book – easy to understand on Anti-Doping Rule with illustrations – are distributed by the ITU officials to all triathletes at the competition brief meeting.

In the lead up to Tokyo 2020 Olympics and Paralympics as a host country, ITU, JADA and JTU will extend the partnership programme to promote the clean sport/triathlon in aim to protect the integrity in sport.
