# JADA and TIAS collaboration delivered the lecture for master course students on "Anti-Doping: Integrity and Values of Sport"

As part of the continuous collaboration between the Japan Anti-Doping Agency (JADA) and Tsukuba International Academy for Sport Studies (TIAS), "Anti-Doping: Integrity and Values of Sport" lecture was delivered to the TIAS 4th Batch Master course students on 29<sup>th</sup> - 31<sup>st</sup> October 2018.

As part of Sport for Tomorrow (SFT), Japanese government legacy project, TIAS aims to foster the next generation of leaders in the world of sport. Under the mutual cooperation of SFT, and also as part of "PLAY TRUE 2020", JADA has been supporting this course as a lecturer since 2015. As part of international sport science education, Anti-Doping is a mandatory subject at TIAS.

24 TIAS students attended 10 lectures over 3 days and they had the opportunity to think how to protect and develop integrity and fairness in sport from the Anti-Doping perspective. Lectures are consisted of classroom-style learning and active learning. Each student also played their role like the IOC, IPC, elite athlete and coach from the point of view of the role and responsibilities stipulated in anti-doping rule.

Furthermore, the students enjoyed learning the values of sport through JADA original values-based education program called "New MO!" through adding the rules to make it fun, fair and respect.







Professor Barrie Houlihan from Loughborough University as a special lecturer explained the definition and relationship between "integrity" and "ethical principles" from a wider perspective.

The students are expected to acquire a wider perspective of international sport governance based on global anti-doping framework and apply it to the activity as part of their future profession.

Some of the TIAS alumni have already applied their experience and knowledge learned through Anti-Doping lectures to their professional field. For example, one of the 1<sup>st</sup> Batch graduates who currently works at the British School in Tokyo uses JADA's "Real Champion Education Package" to raise children's awareness on values of sport, while the 3<sup>rd</sup> Batch student is writing a research paper in order to develop an anti-doping organization in his home country.
